ho of	ATEGORY 3: Families with Children and Youth: An unaccompanied youth who does not qualify as omeless under the Category 1 of the homeless definition, but qualifies as homeless under section 725(2) f the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, and the parent(s) or guardian(s) or child or youth is ving with them.
