HOUSING AND HEALTHCARE RESOURCE LEVERAGING COMMITMENT INSTRUCTIONS

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) continues to emphasize on the need for communities to leverage housing and healthcare resources. As part of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) local competition process, new projects and/or expansion projects are **required** to demonstrate how leverage housing resources and/or healthcare resources contribute to the overall budget of the project proposed through letters of commitment, contracts, or other formal written documents.

Proposed Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) and Rapid Rehousing (RRH) projects must demonstrate leveraging of housing and/or healthcare resources.

<u>Leveraging Housing Resources</u>: Proposed projects leveraging housing resources must demonstrate utilization of housing subsidies or subsidized housing units not funded through the CoC or Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs. Housing subsidies or subsidized housing units may be funded through any of the following sources:

- Private organizations;
- State or local government, including through the use of HOME funding provided through the American Rescue Plan;
- Public Housing Agencies, including through the use of a general or limited preference;
- Faith-based organizations; or
- Federal programs other than the CoC or ESG programs.

The project must demonstrate that these housing units will:

- i. in the case of a PSH project, provide at least 25 percent of the units included in the project; or
- ii. in the case of a RRH project, serve at least 25 percent of the program participants anticipated to be served by the project.

Proposed projects <u>must attach</u> letters of commitment, contracts, or other formal written documents that demonstrate the number of subsidies or units being provided to support the project, as part of Attachment 11.

<u>Leveraging Healthcare Resources</u>: Proposed projects leveraging healthcare resources must demonstrate utilization of healthcare resources to help individuals and families experiencing homelessness. Sources of health care resources include:

- Direct contributions from a public or private health insurance provider to the project (e.g., Medicaid), and
- Provision of health care services by a private or public organization (e.g., Ryan White funded organization) tailored to the program participants of the project.

Eligibility for the project must comply with HUD program and fair housing requirements and

cannot be restricted by the eligibility requirements of the health care service provider.

The project <u>must demonstrate a written commitment</u> from a health care organization, as part of Attachment 12, that:

- in the case of a substance use disorder treatment or recovery provider, it will provide
 access to treatment or recovery services for all program participants who qualify and
 choose those services; or
- ii. the value of assistance being provided is at least an amount that is equivalent to 25 percent of the funding being requested for the project, which will be covered by the healthcare organization.

Acceptable forms of commitment are formal written agreements and must include:

- value of the commitment, and
- dates the healthcare resources will be provided.

In-kind resources must be valued at the local rates consistent with the amount paid for services not supported by grant funds.

Please submit resource leveraging letters of commitment, contracts, or other formal written documents for your proposed project. Please feel free to reference CoC Program Housing and Healthcare Resource Leveraging Commitment Letter Template attached but note that the letter template is not an exhaustive list of considerations; therefore, your agency can include additional information and context as needed.
