Intergroup Relations & Relationship Building

- **Relationship Building, Outreach, & Presentations**
 - Commission staff attended the UCI CCR quarterly meeting for campus updates on policies/outside organizations and violence prevention updates.
 - Commission staff met with CAIR-LA to reestablish communication and collaboration in anti-hate work and the Hate Crime Prevention Network.
 - Commission staff has met with LA vs Hate Program staff to talk about 2022 outreach engagement events.
 - Commission Director met with several CBOs to discuss interest in becoming part of the expanded anti-hate effort.
 - Commission staff presented on hate crimes and bystander intervention for a group of 40+ high school students at OCCEC (OC Christian Evangelical Church). Dr. Judy Wu, UCI Director of Humanities also presented on the history of anti-Asian sentiments.


4 Total Hate-Motivated Events Reported

HATE CRIMES VS. HATE INCIDENTS




Out of the 4 hate-motivated events, two hate crime and two hate incidents were reported


SENTIMENT
