- I. **Call to Order/Introductions/Opening Remarks:** Meeting was called to order by Chair Doug Chaffee who announced the new Chief of Police from Tustin, Chief Thuilliez, will fill the vacancy on the OCCJCC as the small city police chief. The Council acknowledged and congratulated Martin Schwarz on his retirement effective July 11, 2025 and welcomed Sara Nakada as his successor.
- II. **Review and Approval of Minutes:** Meeting Minutes of May 16, 2025, were approved. The motion was made by Supervisor Don Wager and seconded by County Executive Officer Michelle Aguirre. Approved unanimously.
- III. **Proposition 47 Grant Proposals:** Two presentations were made, one by the Office of Care Coordination and the other by the Health Care Agency, which included proposals to support the County's implementation of Prop 36 by funding additional resources and a dedicated multi-disciplinary team for care coordination. It was noted that the grant included a requirement for a local advisory board for which the OCCJCC would serve in that capacity, if awarded.
- IV. **Prop 36 Ad Hoc Update:** No significant updates were provided. The Ad Hoc continues to meet and efforts moving forward regarding the Pretrial Arraignment project are anticipated to help with some of the early concerns identified with Prop 36 impacts.
- V. **Regional Reentry Success Center Update:** A visual update of the progress being made for the County's next Reentry Success Center was provided for the space at the Manchester Office Building. This project is anticipated to be completed by the end of July and will provide juvenile reentry services and workforce reentry services.
- VI. **OCCJCC Comments:** There were no committee comments.
- VII. **Public Comments:** There were no public comments.
