Dana Point Harbor Dock and Patrol Building Renovation

The County of Orange Harbor Patrol building and docks, originally constructed in 1972, are aging and in need of renovations to support the infrastructure necessary to more effectively protect and serve the public. This project involves renovating both the County's Harbor Patrol building in Dana Point Harbor, which is used by the Orange County Sheriff's Department, and the associated existing docks to enhance security, functionality, and safety at the facility.

Project Status

If awarded, CPF dollars would support the purchase of essential equipment, engineering and architectural design services, regulatory permits, and construction costs.
