Dear Senator Padilla, Senator Schiff, Representatives Correa, Kim, Sánchez, Levin, Min, and Tran:

On behalf of the Orange County Board of Supervisors, I write to request your support for the County of Orange's community project funding request of \$1 million for the Patrol Vehicle Technology Modernization project. This project will update and standardize the technology systems within the County of Orange, the Sheriff-Coroner's Department patrol vehicle fleet to ensure vehicles are equipped with current public safety tools.

Many in-vehicle systems are outdated and do not consistently support today's real-time operational emergency response needs. Investments in enhanced communications equipment and integration of digital tools will improve situational awareness, communications, and operational efficiency for deputies on patrol.

New technology components include in-car computers, advanced communications systems, automatic license plate reader capability, and camera and digital evidence. This modernization supports the County's public safety goals by improving field communications, strengthening access to timely information, and enhancing the ability to capture and manage critical evidence.
