- I. **Call to Order/Introductions/Opening Remarks:** Meeting opened welcoming the new Presiding Judge Sheila Hanson, Assistant Presiding Judge Terri Flynn-Peister and the Anaheim Chief of Police to the Council.
- II. **Review and Approval of Minutes:** Meeting Minutes of November 21, 2025, were approved. The motion was made by Supervisor Don Wagner and seconded by Judge Craig Arthur. Approved unanimously.
- III. **Discussion of OCCJCC Bylaws:** Proposed revisions to the OCCJCC Bylaws that included the addition of the Health Care Agency as a voting member and the delegation of authority from the OCCJCC Chair to another voting member to facilitate meetings in their absence. Direction was provided to bring the revisions to the next OCCJCC meeting for approval.
- IV. **Approval of Meeting Calendar for 2026:** Proposed meeting schedule for calendar year 2026 was presented which maintained the meetings for the third Friday of each month and kept the current start time of 9:30am. The motion to approve was made by Supervisor Wagner and seconded by Judge Sheila Hanson. Approved unanimously.
- V. **Discussion: 2026 Goals and Objectives:** Brief discussion on cross-department collaborations and external partners to maintain and enhance the system of care. A status was provided on the recidivism study currently underway by the County's Data and Metrics Unit.
- VI. **General Updates:** The Quarterly Report for the period ending December 31, 2025, was received by the Council. Updated statistics for Prop 36 for calendar year 2025 were shared with a request to include the topic on a future meeting for a more detailed discussion. Chief Daniel Hernandez provided an update on Probation's Prop 47 grant and the focus on diversion programs.
